



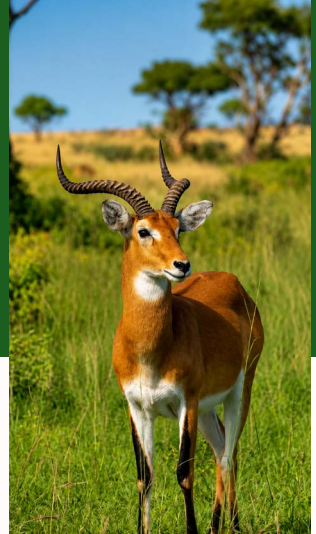

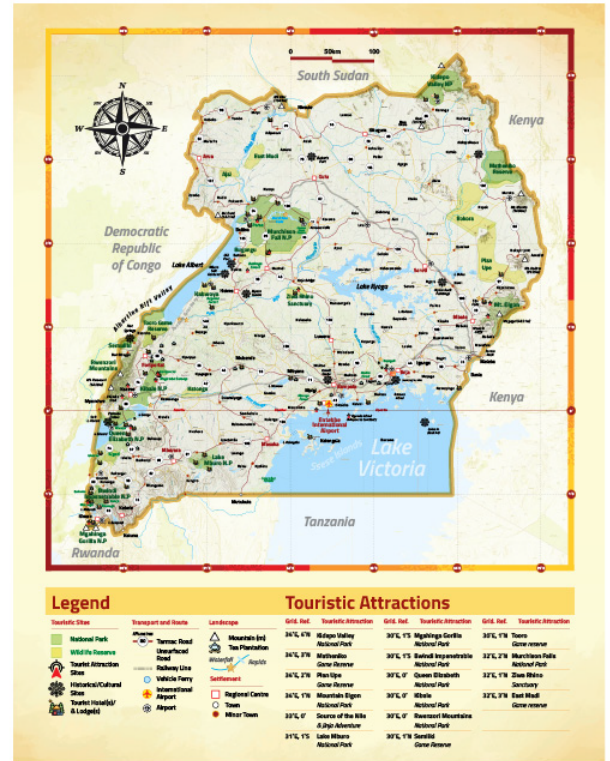

Gorilla Trekking

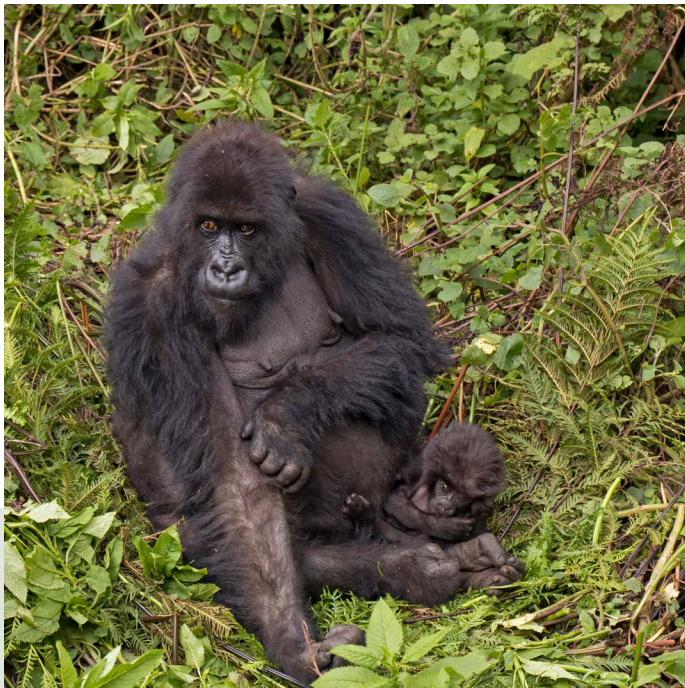
Uganda is one of the world's top destinations for **mountain gorilla trekking**, home to more than half of the world's remaining mountain gorillas. This extraordinary experience allows visitors to observe these endangered primates in their natural rainforest habitat while supporting conservation and local communities.



Gorilla trekking takes place in **Bwindi Impenetrable National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and **Mgahinga Gorilla National Park**, both located in southwestern Uganda. Guided by experienced Uganda Wildlife Authority (UWA) rangers, visitors hike through lush forests to locate a habituated gorilla family.

The trek may last from **1 to 6 hours**, depending on the gorillas' location, followed by one **unforgettable hour observing their fascinating behavior**.

The best time to trek is during the dry seasons (June–September and December–February), although gorilla trekking is available throughout the year. Visitors should wear sturdy hiking boots, long-sleeved clothing, and carry a waterproof jacket, drinking water, insect repellent, and a camera without flash.



Gorilla trekking is more than a safari—it is a rare opportunity to connect with one of humanity's closest relatives in the wild while contributing to the preservation of one of Africa's greatest natural treasures. For many travelers, it is the highlight of their journey through the Pearl of Africa.



Bird Watching

Uganda is one of the world's premier birdwatching destinations, earning its reputation as **the Birding Paradise of Africa**. Despite its relatively small size, the country is home **to more than 1,090 recorded bird species**, representing about **11% of the world's bird species and over 50% of Africa's bird species**. Its remarkable diversity is due to a unique combination of tropical rainforests, wetlands, savannahs, mountains, lakes, and rivers. Whether you are a seasoned birder or a nature enthusiast, Uganda offers unforgettable birdwatching experiences throughout the year, with opportunities to spot rare, endemic, and migratory species in spectacular natural settings.

Top Birdwatching Destinations

Mabamba Swamp

World-famous for sightings of the elusive Shoebill Stork, this wetland is best explored by canoe through narrow papyrus channels.

Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Known for gorilla trekking, Bwindi is also a birdwatcher's paradise with over 350 bird species, including many Albertine Rift endemics such as the African Green Broadbill and Handsome Francolin.

Kibale National Park

Home to more than 370 bird species, Kibale's tropical rainforest shelters the Great Blue Turaco, Green-breasted Pitta, hornbills, and numerous forest specialists.

Murchison Falls National Park

Combining savannah, riverine forests, and wetlands, the park boasts over 450 bird species, including the African Fish Eagle, Goliath Heron, & Abyssinian Ground Hornbill.

Queen Elizabeth National Park

One of Uganda's richest birding areas with over 600 bird species, offering excellent sightings around the Kazinga Channel, crater lakes, and open savannah.

Best Time for Birdwatching

Uganda offers excellent birdwatching year-round. The dry seasons (December–February and June–August)



Big Five Wild Safaris

Top Wildlife Safari Destinations

1. Murchison Falls National Park

Famous for elephants, lions, giraffes, buffaloes, hippos, crocodiles, and the spectacular Murchison Falls.

Renowned for tree climbing lions, elephants, leopards, and boat safaris along the Kazinga Channel.

3. Kidepo Valley National Park

Wildlife safaris are enjoyable year round, but the dry seasons (December–February and June–August) offer the best game viewing, with animals gathering around water sources and roads remaining easily accessible.

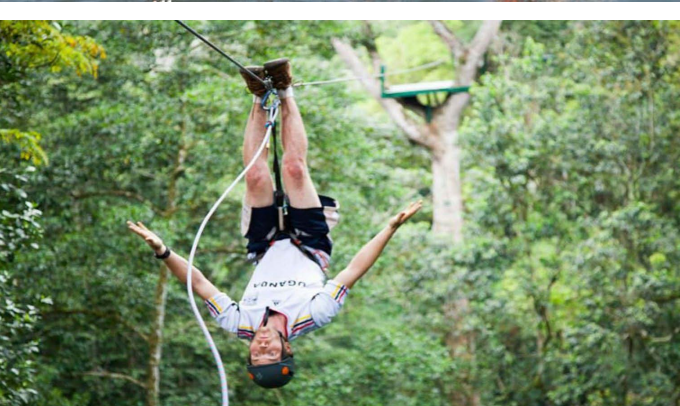

Entry Basics: All U.S. travelers need a Visa Arranged before you go to Uganda for \$50.

2. Best Time to Go TO UGANDA:

For Gorilla Trekking in the dry season,
June – September, and then December – February.

Bespoke Safaris,

June to September and December to February.

Birding Safaris,

December – February.

Culture Tours and Religious,

Tours are available all year round.

Note: No Vaccinations Required To Travel To Uganda.

Note: Travel times are approximate and assume efficient connections. Actual durations may vary depending on airline schedules, layover lengths, weather, and seasonal operations.

Practical booking tips

1. Check Brussels Airlines and KLM for one-stop transatlantic + Europe → EBB combinations
2. Turkish Airlines often provides strong single-connection service via IST.
3. Ethiopian Airlines and Kenya Airways offer consistent Africa-hub connections (ADD, NBO).
4. For shortest travel time, choose an itinerary with a single connection in Europe or Istanbul and a short layover (1–3 hours). For best Comfort, choose Business on the long transatlantic leg (US → Europe/Middle East) and Business/Comfort on the Europe → EBB leg if available.

Travel Preparation Checklist

Passport: Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your travel dates and has enough blank pages.

Visa & Entry: Apply for your e-Visa in advance (typically approved within 48–72 hours).

UG Tourism Consult can assist with the application process.

Health: Check the latest health requirements for your destination. Consult your doctor about malaria prevention and other travel health needs. Uganda no longer requires Yellow Fever vaccination for entry.

Travel Insurance: We recommend comprehensive travel insurance that includes medical coverage and emergency evacuation.

Money & Connectivity: Carry some cash for tips and souvenirs. Credit/debit cards are accepted in many places. Consider purchasing an eSIM or local SIM card to stay connected.
